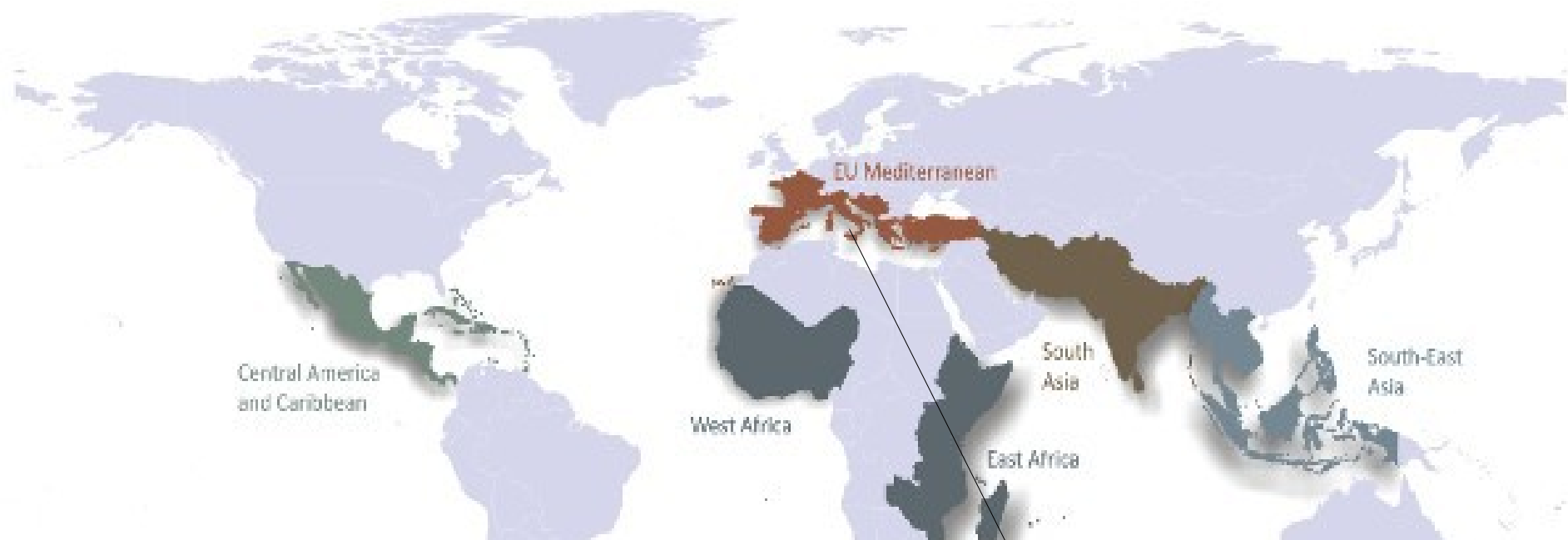


# CATALYST-Local

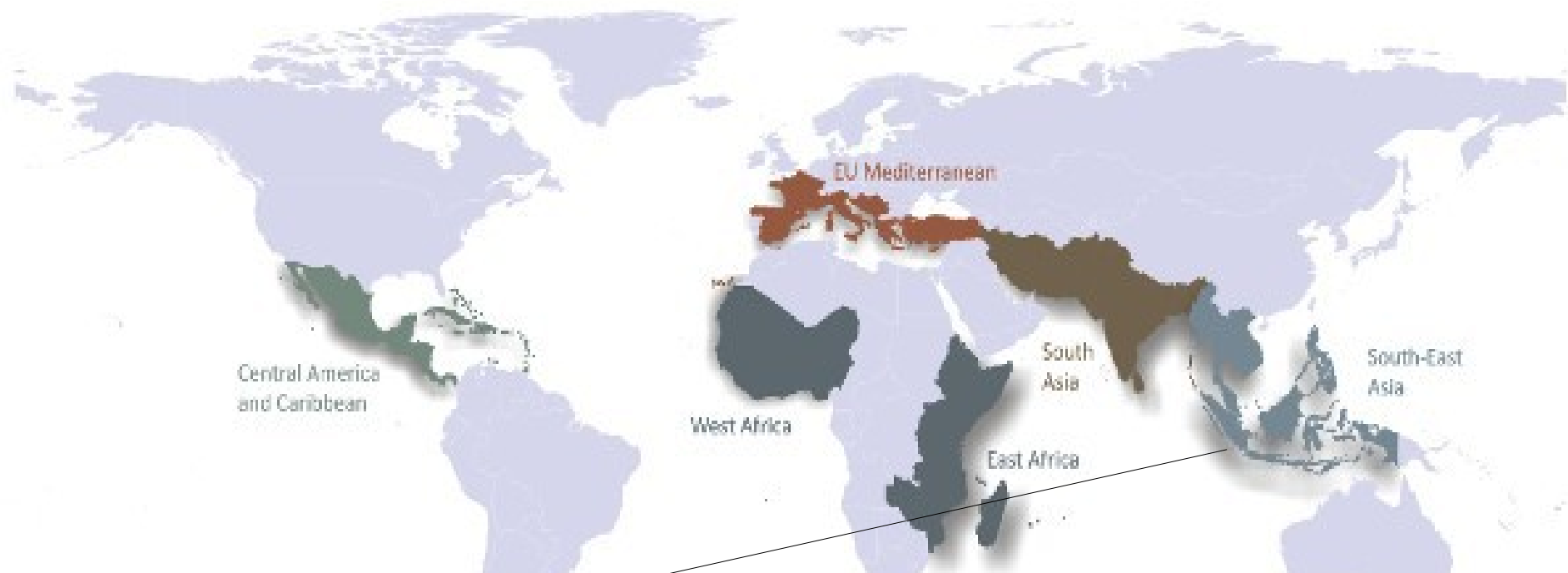
- Responds to strong demand from Think Tank Members

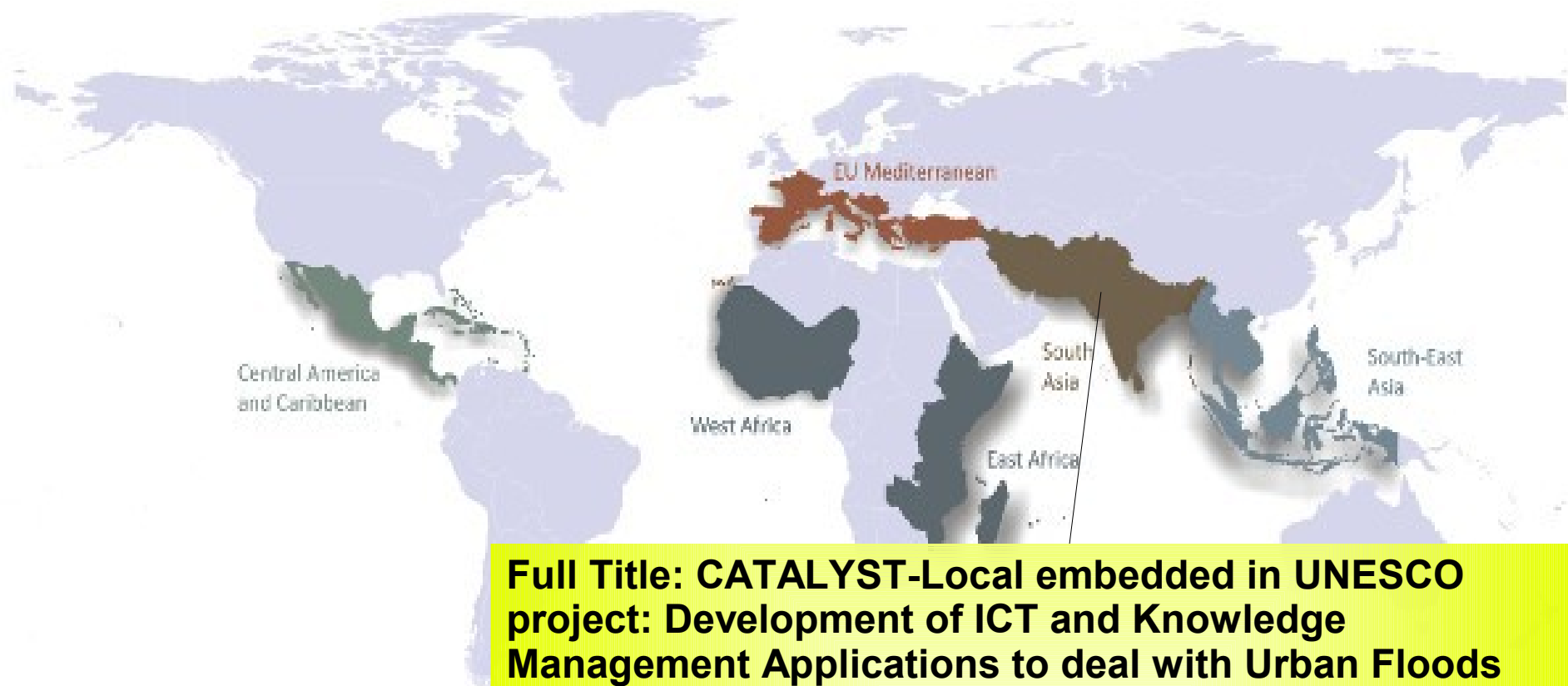
